Sir,

In reply to the Classing Letter dated 22/2/21, respecting the S.S. "CITY OF CAMBRIDGE", I beg to state that a web frame has been fitted in the deep tank and that a screen bulkhead equivalent to a web frame has been fitted in the machinery space as approved; that the bulkheads throughout are constructed in accordance with the approved plans or the Rules and Tables in force prior to the amendments adopted in May 1915; that the riveting of the tank, top centre strake, and the spacing of the rivets in butts of the upper deck sheerstrake and strake below clear of the bridge are as required by the Rules; that the tank top plating is increased in thickness in way of hatchways; that a hand pump is fitted to the fore peak and that the spacing of the floors is as approved.
