the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Vickers Ltd., Barrow, examine at the works of Messrs. Peter Brotherhood Ltd., Peterborough, a three stage steam driven air compressor for their motor vessel No.570.

The compressor numbered 16650 was run upon the test bench at Messrs. Peter Brotherhood's works for two hours on 14th April 1920, running coolly and well with almost an entire absence of vibration.

After the test the compressor valves were opened out and appeared in good condition.

Result of Test:-


