C. I think it well to advise you that reports of surveys held at Bombay and Port Natal in January and February this year on the "WARDANA", i.e. before she was unfortunately lost, have recently come to hand and have been placed before the Committee.

These surveys entitled the ship to records of special survey on the hull and machinery, and ordinarily certificates would have been issued accordingly.

As the ship, however, is a casualty, you will probably not want these certificates, but if you would like to have them to complete your records I shall be glad if you will let me know when I shall have pleasure in forwarding them to you.


