Dear Sir,

A. With reference to your letter of the 7th instant, respecting the fees chargeable in the case of the Steamer "NARDANA" (Glasgow First Entry Report No. 39167) I have to inform you that the proportion of the fees which will be chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of the Hull will be 40% of the difference between the fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees, and for the survey of the machinery 50%, which in this case amount to say £53 and £50 respectively.

An account has to-day been rendered to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for these fees, and, on payment, your account will be credited accordingly.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
