
The 2nd S.S.No.1 became due in 2,31 and no part of the survey has been held.

The class is subject to indented plating on starboard side being dealt with at Owners' convenience. The vessel requires to be specially examined at the next docking (grounding).

The vessel has been laid up/since 4,30 <sup>at Falmouth</sup> and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

The vessel has been sold to Messrs. Douglas & Ramsey, Glasgow, for breaking up and in reply to enquiry the Glasgow Secretary states that the new Owners do not desire the vessel to proceed to her breaking up port as a classed ship.

It is submitted the vessel might be posted "To be broken up".
