This case is fully stated in endorsement dated 2.3.34, when the Owners were informed that it was considered that the vessel should be generally examined in order to entitle her to retain her class in the Register Book.

A letter has now been received from the Liverpool Office enclosing one from the Owners stating that there does not seem to be any likelihood of the vessel being moved for some time to come, and that she has been well looked after during her lay up. In these circumstances they do not think the examination would do any good and would only involve them in unnecessary expense.

In view of the above and of their undertaking to submit the vessel for 2nd S.S.No.1 before she leaves British waters they request that the general examination be waived.

It might be pointed out to the Owners that the vessel will not require to be specially opened up or cleaned, and the examination is for the purpose of ascertaining if the vessel is in satisfactory condition to retain her class while laid up.

The year of grace expired 2,32.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
