We have your letter of 6th inst. re above-named steamer, and note that "your Committee consider she should be submitted to a general examination in order to entitle her to retain her class in the Register Book.

In reply we beg to say that the steamer has not been moved since our last correspondence on her in 1932, and there does not seem to be any likelihood of moving her for some time to come. But she has been well looked after during her "lay-up".

Under these circumstances, we do not think that a "general examination" would do any good or further matters: rather it would be an unnecessary expense in these lean times. Moreover, we confirm our promise to submit the steamer to your Surveyors for her S.S.2nd No.1 before she leaves British waters.

Trusting, therefore, that your Committee will not consider it necessary to hold the "general examination" to which you refer and that you will be good enough to advise us accordingly - in due course; we remain, Dear Sir,
