vessel is still on the rocks. Last week salvage operations were  
suspended owing to bad weather.

It is impossible at present to give you any information  
regarding the extent of the damage, and according to information we  
received towards the end of last week from our Gibraltar Agents, the  
salvors are optimistic of refloating the steamer.

The latest information is that the weather has moderated  
and that last Saturday the salvage steamers "Rescue" and "Hermes"  
restarted operations.
