80 miles from Shanghai, 13.3.1929.

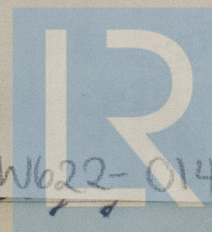
In reply to your favour of the 10th inst. we beg to inform you, that the s.s. "Giessen" must be considered a total loss, as the ship is broken in two and mostly submerged. The Tokio Salvage Company has signed a contract of LLOYDS FORM on the basis "no cure, no pay" and will try to salvage as much cargo as possible.

Under these circumstances we think, that the vessel's character could be expunged from the Register-Book.
