SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

BAYESKIMO.—London, July 25. — The Hudson's Bay Company have to-day received the following cable from the master of the steamer Nascopie: Steamer Bayeskimo sank in lat. 59 15 N., long. 67 15 W., on July 23. Received distress call when 160 miles apart. Rescued all hands, July 24; proceeding Burwell, all well.

BAYESKIMO.—London, July 29. — The Hudson's Bay Company state that the steamer Nascopie arrived at Burwell July 25, and landed the crew of steamer Bayeskimo.

BAYESKIMO.—London, Aug. 10.—In reply to inquiry for further particulars regarding the loss of the above steamer, the Hudson's Bay Company have received the following cable from Montreal: Cannot obtain reply to date from either Parsons or Lloyd (master of Bayeskimo), latter expected to arrive about Aug. 14. Have requested him to telegraph immediately information desired failing earlier advice of Parsons.

BAYESKIMO.—London, Aug. 13. — The Hudson's Bay Company have received the following wireless message from the master of the steamer Bayeskimo: Resulting from damage by ice Bayeskimo foundered Ungava Bay, July 23. Harmony transporting crew Burwell to St. John's.
