S.S. "CASSIS"


S.S. Sng. No.3 = 8,26

This vessel is a petroleum carrier, built in 1914 - 4 mo., and is owned by the Anglo Saxon Petroleum Co.

The 2nd S.S.No.1 became due in 8,30, and the Newcastle Surveyors now report that from a general examination general wastage was observed in the transverse bulkheads, centre line bulkheads and bulkhead stiffeners and brackets, side longitudinals, fore and after bottom girders, transverses, trunk sides, main and weather deck plating. The vessel is now laid up and nothing further has been done towards the S.S.No.1.

It is submitted that, in view of the report received from the Newcastle Surveyors, Mr. Lewis, Special Surveyor for Steel at Glasgow, might be instructed to examine this vessel, but in the meantime the Newcastle Surveyors should be requested to state if arrangements can be made for Mr. Lewis to make an inspection.
