In reply to your request in the Classing Letter of the 23rd instant, relating to the S.S. "GRIQUA" Newcastle Report No.44,584, I beg to state that a Steel water tight-bulkhead has been fitted in the after hold extending to the Spar Deck as shown on the approved pumping plan, making 6 Bulkheads in all.

The Moulded Depth to the main deck is 19' 8".

With reference to the Owners Letter respecting the fitting of Close Ceiling, the original letter was retained in order to attach same to the First Entry report on the Sister Vessel, No.731.
