Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 4<sup>th</sup> inst. re s/s "War Down". I beg to state, the butts of the Bridge sheer strake are quadruple riveted; the butts of the strake below same are treble riveted throughout; three web frames are fitted at forward end of vessel; and the floors clear of double bottom are .46 thick. The butts of D. strake are quadruple riveted for  $\frac{1}{2}$  L. & treble at ends. Built pillars are fitted at ends of hatchways as approved. Second means of steering is provided with leads to winch. I regret this information was not given on 1<sup>st</sup> Entry Report.
