Dear Sirs,

With reference to your First Entry Report on the S.S. "WAR DOWN", I have to request that you will be so good as to state whether the butts of the bridge sheerstrake are quadruple, and of the strake below treble throughout the length of the bridge; that three web frames are fitted at the forward end as required, and the floors at the end of the vessel clear of the double bottom are .4 in thickness as required.

Will you also state if you are correct in reporting that the butts of "D" strake are treble riveted for full length, and whether built pillars are fitted at the end of the hatchways as required, also whether a second means of steering has been provided by means of relieving tackles.
