With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "EMPRESS", I beg to remind you that the Second Special Survey No.3 became due on this vessel in June 1930 and has not yet been completed.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting to-day, together with a communication from the Society's Surveyor at St. John, N.B., who states that the vessel is still laid up at that port and he has no information as to when she will be put into commission.

In the circumstances and in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Special Survey has now expired, I have to say that the Committee will be agreeable to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present, whilst laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking, which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office.
