us the amended figures as early as possible.

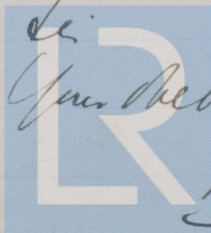
The Certificate of Classification relating to Hull was
