I duly received your letter of the 11th ultimo in reply to mine of the 25th October regarding the reported loss of the Japanese Steamer "YONAN MARU", and I am much obliged for the information and remarks forwarded, which have been noted with interest.

I shall be glad if you will let me know whether you are in possession of any information as to the method of stowage of the grain cargo - whether this was stowed in bulk, or whether it was stowed partly in bags, and it would also be of advantage to know whether shifting boards and feeders were fitted, in view of the statement that the vessel had undertaken many Pacific Voyages under similar conditions.

Perhaps also you might be able to obtain information as to the density of the wood which was carried in the tween decks and on deck respectively.
