With reference to the reports which have appeared in the press regarding the probable loss of the Japanese Steamer "YONAN MARU", No. 38950 in the Register Book, it is observed that the vessel appears to have been carrying a deckload of timber, and if fully loaded the proportions of breadth to draught would indicate a reserve of stability below the average.

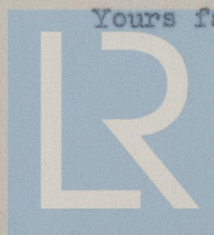
