August 1931 and subsequently whilst the vessel lay in Osaka Iron Works, dry dock at Imoshima, for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of damage stated to have been caused by striking No. 8 buoy on the 7th. August 1931 at Shanghai, whilst shifting berth.

Shell plates. Port side.

No. 3 plate from forward end in D strake indented.

To be removed, faired and refitted.

No. 2 plate from forward end in E strake slightly indented.

To be faired in place.

One longitudinal slightly bent at 2 places.

Port side Bilge Keel.

Forward end of bilge keel buckled about 20 feet in length to and broken.

be renewed with shell angle.

Starboard side, Bilge Keel.

No. 3 length from forward end buckled.

To be removed, faired and refitted and shell angle to be faired in place.

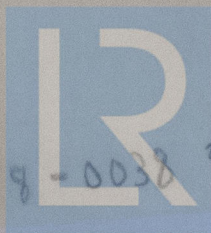
It was further recommended that all broken and disturbed cement be renewed.
