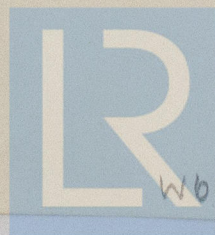
The Owners now write, as follows:-

"This steamer, now running in her year of grace for 2nd No. 3 expiring at the end of September has to make a voyage to South and East Africa, also Red Sea ports, and finally arrives in the U.K. at the end of October, 1930. Under these circumstances we shall be pleased to hear from you that her class will not be disturbed over this period. In February of this year your Senior Surveyor, Mr. Boyle examined the steamer at Durban; also Boiler Survey has just been completed. The steamer is now at Birkenhead, which port she leaves at the end of this week. The homeward loading commences at Mombassa P.T.O.
