Précis of particulars of Casualty

This steamer went ashore S.E. of Curacao D.W.I. on the 27th. May, 1930. She was floated on the 15th. June, taken to Willemstad and dry docked.

In a letter dated the 27th. June the Owners stated that the extent of damage was so great that there was a possibility of disposing of the vessel as she lay.

The Curacao Surveyors surveyed the vessel in dry dock, and reported damage to keel, shell plating, floors, tank margin brackets, rudder carried away &c. Temporary repairs were effected, and as the dry dock was required she was floated and moored in the harbour.

On 22nd. August action was deferred for permanent repairs &c.

It now appears from the BOARD OF TRADE RETURN dated October, 1930 that the vessel's British Register has been closed with the notation "Stranded 27.5.30".

In reply to enquiry that Owners now state that owing to the high cost of repairs the vessel has become a C.T.L. She is being dismantled and will be sunk at an early date.
