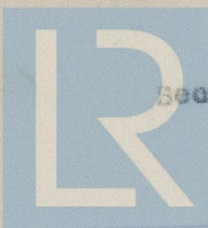
With further reference to your letter of the 27th last respecting your S.S. "RIMULA", I beg to acquaint you that a report was duly received from the Society's Surveyors at the close of their examination of the vessel in dry dock on account of the heavy damage sustained through stranding near London on the 27th May last, and I am directed to say that the Committee will be much obliged if you will be so good as to say whether or not it is intended to pursue with regard to the repair of the vessel.

The question of making a record of the circumstances connected with the vessel's name in the Register Book will shortly come under the Committee's notice, and it is the practice in cases where it is thought necessary to make such a notation, to delete at the same time the vessel's class from the Register Book. I shall be glad if you will kindly apprise me, for the Committee's information, of your views on this point.
