Nature of Survey

1st Entry

It is submitted the Newcastle Surveyors be informed that this vessel is proceeding to this port to have the machinery installed.

To complete the survey on the hull the tunnel requires to be completed and tested, steering gears (Steam hand), windlass & winches to be tested, upper deck hatches to be examined in position, doubling plates under sounding pipes to be properly secured.

On completion of the survey a report on Form 8 should be forwarded.

The Middlesbrough Surveyors should be informed it is concluded the twelve inch hatch and pillars and the face bar on the ^{lower} 2nd deck transverse beams are as approved but they should state if this is so, they should also state the process of the manufacture of the steel.
