

Dear Sir:-

Reverting to your letter of the 16th. ultimo relative to the screw shaft and boiler survey on the Steamer "INVERAMPTON", which became due at the end of August and the end of September, respectively, I beg to advise that this vessel has left for Trinidad where, according to my information, the surveys in question will be carried out.

I took this matter up with the Company's Marine Superintendent at Aruba and, after considering it fully and taking into consideration that dry docking facilities are not yet available at Aruba, it was considered advisable not to tip the vessel at San Nicholas to enable the screw shaft to be drawn in but to place her in dock for this purpose.


