With reference to your First Entry Report on the S.S. "MCNEYSPINNER" No.8045, I shall be glad if you will be good enough to state whether the rivets in the butts of the keel plate are spaced $3\frac{1}{2}$ diameters as required by the rules; also whether you are correct in reporting that the coal bunker openings are flush with the deck, as it would appear from the plans that the bunker hatch is fitted on top of the fidley casing.
