STEAMERS "WEAR", VECTIS" & "BROMSGROVE"

Referring to our letter of the 7th instant we thank you for the courtesy extended to our Mr. Wilson when he visited you on Tuesday, 19th instant, regarding the above and he has today reported to us the result of that interview.

The question of the "WEAR" as you know, has already been disposed of as the ship has been sold to break up, but in regard to the "VECTIS" this vessel, as you were informed is still running and we are very desirous of continuing to run her as long as ever possible, and we will be glad if the Committee would grant a further extension of six months on this ship.

It is not our intention to put the ship through the Special Survey but as she has already completed the main and donkey boiler surveys and has been in drydock for examination by your Surveyors we think the Committee might reasonably grant the request we are making.
