I have to report that I found Fore-mast & fore-top-mast in good condition, Derricks also were good. Links, shackles, houndbands & eyes were sound. Rigging, bottle screws, shackles, eye plates were good. Bunker sampson posts & derricks in good condition. Rigging of same, also bottle screws, eyes, shackles & eyeplates quite sound.

Main-mast & main-top-mast in good condition. Ironwork on mast good. Derricks & ironwork including bands, links, shackles & eyes good.

Main-mast rigging, bottle screws, shackles & eyeplates good.
