Sir,

We beg to enclose herewith a plan of the main boiler being fitted on board the steamer "WITIAZ" in place of the original donkey boiler.

This boiler was built by Messrs Dunsmuir & Jackson of Glasgow for Messrs Howden & Co., of the same port, who, in 1916, disposed of it to Messrs Workman Clark & Co., Ltd., in whose Power it has since done service at a working pressure of 160 lbs square inch.

It has now been examined internally and externally with mountings, and found to be in efficient condition, and it is tested No. 13,000, Lloyd's Test 370 lbs per sq. inch. W.G.M. 14/1/15

The scantlings as given on the enclosed plan have been verified with the boiler as constructed.

It is submitted that, as this boiler is to be worked as a main boiler at a pressure of 170 lbs per sq. inch, the notations on the R.B. having reference to the boilers be altered to include and we should be glad to know if this will be in order.

Messrs Workman Clark & Co., Ltd., state they are unable
