I have to confirm the following cablegram which was sent to you to-day in this matter, viz:-

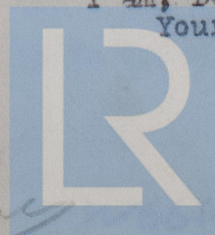
"Steamer RABAT 69719 new Owners Macandrews desire
