Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant, confirming the purchase from Messrs. T. & J. Harrison, of Liverpool, of the s.s. "AUTHOR", for delivery to you at Liverpool, and note that it is intended to take the steamer with a non-perishable cargo from a port in the U.K. or Continent to the Upper Adriatic, where immediately after completion of discharge she will be broken up.

In confirmation of the intimation made to your Representative this morning regarding the issue of an interim certificate, I have to inform you that it will be necessary for the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool to carry out a general examination, with a view to ascertaining that the vessel is in a fit condition for the intended voyage, and I am writing them to-day asking them to arrange to carry out the necessary inspection on Tuesday morning next, when it is understood your Representative will be present.
