Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to inform you that I am in receipt of a letter from Messrs. Thos. & Jas. Harrison of Liverpool stating that they have just sold their steamer "AUTHOR" to you as she lies with a guarantee that she will be broken up in Italy.

As you are doubtless aware the year of grace within which the Second Special Survey No.2 should have been completed expired at the end of February, and as the vessel is at present laid up her classification has been continued on the understanding that the survey in question will be carried out before she goes into commission, otherwise her class will be automatically cancelled.

In view, however, of the late Owners' statement that she is to be broken up in Italy, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know what your intentions are in the matter.
