The *1st* S.S. No. */* partly held at *Kobe*

now completed, and the following repairs done due to wear and tear:-

Minor repairs effected.

After floor in After Peak Tank now permanently repaired
Vessel placed in dry dock & bottom recoated.

Cement removed from double bottom tanks except under engines & boilers. Glass ceiling on 2" cross battens fitted to tank top throughout the holds with a view to carrying oil fuel in D.B. at a later period. The deep tank has been tested for the carriage of vegetable oil.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, with record of Survey *12,22 Kob.* and notation of *S.S. Kob. 17^o1, 21* as recommended.
