Dear Sir,

In reply to the London letter dated 25th instant regarding the first entry report No. 43893 on the Steamer "CARIBOO", I have to say that the test of the stream wire is 59 tons.

In regard to the length and capacity of the double bottom tanks, the two later vessels "CALUMET" and "CARIBOO" are of slightly modified form and this accounts for the difference between the capacities of their tanks and those of the two preceding vessels "CALGARY" and "COCHRANE".

The particulars furnished were as given by the Builders. I have gone into the matter with them again and the particulars now given on the enclosed sheet are taken from the finished capacity plans and are said to be correct.


