With reference to Glasgow first entry report No.43893 on the steamer "CARIBOO", I have to say that it is concluded that the test of the stream wire is 59 tons, but I shall be much obliged if you will be good enough to ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know whether this is so.

I shall also be glad to know whether the length and capacities of the cellular double bottom tanks of this vessel and the s.s. "CALUMET" are correct as now reported, as they do not agree with those given for the sister ships "CALGARY" and "COCHRANE", and in the latter cases the tank under the boilers was stated to be a "dry tank".
