This vessel has been placed in dry dock and the requirements of the S.S.No.1, due 8.28, complied with. The bottom has been recoated and minor repairs effected.

No.1 D.B. tank has now been cemented throughout ~~and~~ in lieu of part cement.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 3.28 and notation of S.S.Cff.No.1-28.
