Dear Sir,

Having reference to your classing-letter of the 29. ult, respecting the steamer "MORA", I beg to inform you that the deep tank abaft the collision bulkhead is used as a ballast tank. Its length is 26 feet and its capacity 157 tons, which are both encluded in the length and capacity of the double bottom forward, stated in my report. I also beg to inform you that this tank has been filled and tested as required by the rules, and that the second deck beams at the fore end of No.1 hold are fitted to every frame, ^{as} indicated on the approved plan.
