Nature of Survey

The s.s. No.1 due 9-24 has been partly held.

The Newcastle Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock and damage through grounding and cause not stated repaired as follows:- 3 shell plates removed, faired and refitted, 3 faired in place, a number of rivets renewed in fore peak and minor repairs effected.


The s.s. No.1 has been completed and minor repairs carried out.
