THISTLEBEN.—London, Oct. 5.—The following cable has been received from New York—American steamer HANLEY collided with British steamer Thistleben today (Oct. 4). Latter sunk. HANLEY has forepeak leaking; proceeding New York.

London, Oct. 5.—British steamer Thistleben was sunk yesterday in collision with American steamer HANLEY. The collision occurred off the Florida coast. The crew of the Thistleben were taken on board the HANLEY, which is due in New York on Monday (Oct. 8). The forepeak of the HANLEY is reported to be leaking, but otherwise she suffered no great damage.
