In reply to the queries in the classing letter dated 15th. instant, relating to the Steamer "THISTLEBEN", in the absence of Mr. Collings on holiday leave I have turned up the particulars in his books and find :-

- 2 - 90 " 7" " "
- 2 - 90 " 2½" steel wires.

Five breasthooks were fitted in addition to the decks.
