S. With reference to Liverpool First Entry Report No. 82966 on the Steamer "CONISTON", I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know whether the size of the upper and raised quarter deck stringer angles is as approved and as in the sister vessel and not as reported; whether the thickness of the boss plates is correctly reported, in view of the Rule thickness being .34", and also whether the scantlings of the bridge deck stringer, stringer angle plating, etc. are as required.
