Dear Sir,

Having reference to your letter of the 26th May last respecting the equipment of the s.s. "OHIO" ex "MUENCHEN" I beg to inform you that the anchors and cables were sent to Lloyd's Proving-House at Cardiff for retesting and were found in order, , with the exception of 165 fathoms of 3 1/8 inches stud link cables, instead of which a new cable of the same size and length, made by N. Hingley & Sons has been supplied. The anchors and cables have been sent back to Bremen and it was found that the last named cable has ordinary endlings and shackles which do not fit to the existing cable lifter of the windlass which are constructed for Kenter Shackles. To avoid loss of time, which would be caused by alteration of the cable lifters, it is proposed by the Owners' Representatives at Bremen to cut out the endlings and shackles of this cable and to replace them by Kenter shackles which have also been tested at Cardiff. This would shorten up every length of 150 fathoms by about 52 inches, making a total of about 8 fathoms for the whole length, which the Owners propose

to recompensate by supplying a new length of 150 fathoms. As the case is urgent I should be much obliged for being informed by cablegram whether the Owners' proposal may be accepted.


