ANSWER.

With reference to the above vessel which on fire and sank at Norfolk, Va. on the 12th November 1920, and subsequently was refitted, I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Report News, dated the 28th ultimo, stating that the vessel was not repaired under their supervision with a view to reclassification and they are unable now to ascertain where the vessel is. I shall, therefore, be glad if you will be good enough to ascertain from the Owners and let me know by return mail for the information of the Committee what has become of the vessel.

I am advised by the Owners that this vessel has been repaired, though not yet completely so, and is at present laid up in the James River awaiting an opportunity of being replaced in the service.
