With reference to your letters of the 31st May and 6th instant addressed to the Society's New York Office respecting your wood oil-engined vessel "TROLLTIND", I beg to acquaint you that the case has received the careful consideration of the Committee, and in view of the fact that you do not see your way to furnish the undertaking required, and that in addition to the surveys for which the vessel is overdue considerable repairs are necessary, the Committee do not see how they can allow the vessel's class to remain undisturbed, and have accordingly given instructions for the character to be expunged and a notation of "In port damaged" inserted against the vessel's name in the Society's Register Book.
