

Dear Sir,

M.V. "TROLLTIND".

This motor vessel underwent repairs, drew cash and bought provisions at this port in August-September, 1920. Her Owners remitted promptly two-thirds of her account before she sailed, as the crew were almost mutinous when she was ready to sail, did not detain her for the balance.

Payment was pressed for through New York Agents, and finally through lawyers, but the vessel caught on fire and eventually sank in harbour and we have been utterly unable to obtain any further payment. Under the circumstances we feel we should advise you that we expect to have to ask for the amount of your debit in this case, viz: £21,000, to be reduced by approximately one-third. On writing further from New York we will advise you the exact amount of the reduction.
