With reference to your letter of the 17th instant respecting the S.S. "CHRPSTOW CASTLE" (Glasgow Rpt.No.52447) I have to acquaint you that a communication, dated the 10th instant, was received from the Owners intimating that the vessel had been sold for breaking up, and, in view of the reported extensive damage sustained through the vessel being driven on the rocks at Toward Point on the 7th April, the case was submitted to the Chasing Committee on the 13th instant, when it was decided, in all the circumstances, to expunge the class and insert a record of "Stranded 4.32 - Refloated" against the vessel's name in the Register Book.
