Précis of particulars of Casualty

Vessel is reported from Buenos Ayres to have been driven ashore off Quequen, on 3<sup>rd</sup> April. The reports state:-

"Lies in an exposed position 1 mile from deep water. Italian surveyors report engines shifted. They consider vessel a total loss as cost of refloating, if possible, would exceed value"

A further report states that that engines and boilers are leaky, and the engine-room full of water.

A special casualty notice was sent to the owners on 11<sup>th</sup> April, but no reply has been received.

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

MONTE PASUBIO. Genoa, Apr. 6.—According to a telegram from Buenos Ayres, dated Apr. 3, the Italian steamer Monte Pasubio, owing to a gale and heavy sea, has been driven ashore on the coast of Quequen, and is in a dangerous position. Crew not in danger. Attempts being made to save the vessel. "Corriere Mercantile."

London, Apr. 9.—In reply to inquiry the owners of the steamer Monte Pasubio cable from Genoa Apr. 9 as follows: Monte Pasubio ashore parallel coast four miles south Quequen with serious damage machinery and boilers; leaking; engine-room flooded.

Buenos Ayres, Apr. 9.—Italian steamer Monte Pasubio reported broadside on to beach 700 yards from Quequen breakwater. Lies in an exposed position 1 mile from deep water. Italian surveyors report engines shifted. They consider vessel a total loss, as cost of refloating, if possible, would exceed value.

MONTE PASUBIO. Genoa, Apr. 9.—Italian steamer Monte Pasubio: Owners informed ashore four miles south Quequen. Heavy damage; engines and boilers leaky; engine-room full of water.
