A. With reference to your letter of the 19th instant respecting the Boilers No.M.398 made by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd., (Glasgow first entry report No.38228) and now fitted into the s.s. "WAR GLORY" (now named "MONTE BASUBIO") Messrs.
