

3228. "TROSTAN". To remain as classed subject to the screw shaft being examined on the vessel's arrival at Swansea.

3226. "VILLE D'ALGER". I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant respecting the provisional bower anchor and three lengths of chain cable which have been supplied to this vessel to replace the equipment which was lost, and having submitted the Owners application with regard to the acceptance of the provisional anchor to the Committee to-day, I have to inform you that they have agreed to accept this provisional anchor as part of the vessel's equipment. I may say that the London Officials of the Bureau Veritas have been communicated with on the matter and they have exchanged their certificate of test for this anchor which was forwarded with your letter for the original statutory certificate issued from the Sunderland Proving House, and this certificate is now sent herewith.
