Sir

Reverting to my report 3226 on the steamer "Ville d'Alger" who had one bow anchor and three lengths of chain cables 17 fathoms each lost in course of trial tests, I beg to submit to you the following proposal which is presented by the Builders with the knowledge and consent of the Owners.

The provisional anchor which was placed on board is a new anchor recently ordered for a vessel under construction at Havre at the Forges Chantiers to be claimed with the Bureau Veritas. Under these circumstances the corresponding certificate has been drawn up by the Bureau Veritas.

It is proposed, to suit the interests of the various concerns, to definitively deliver the said anchor who is about 1 cwt 3 qrs over the lost anchor and the case is submitted to your approval.

The certificates both of the lost anchor and

of the proposed anchor as enclosed herewith
and submitted to your supervision.

Three new lengths of chain cables are ordered
to be placed on board on return of the vessel at
Havre.

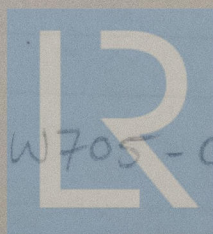
The marks of the anchor were not verified

about five months before acceptance.

but to take into consideration those already
made upon the said anchor.
