Sir,

I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a first entry report from the Society's Surveyors at Havre on the new steamer "VILLE D'ALGER", from which it appears that while this vessel was moored at Havre the port chain cable broke, and three lengths of the cable and a bower anchor were lost. A temporary anchor is stated to have been placed on board, and it is added that as a further temporary measure three lengths of cable will be placed on board for the voyage at your port, and that it is intended to place the equipment in order on the vessel's return from her voyage in about five months' time.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be so good as to give the case the necessary attention, and forward a report in due course on Form S in the usual manner for the information of the Committee.
